Sichuan Airlines' Inaugural Flight at Yangon International Airport (YIA)

YANGON – **13 November 2018** – Sichuan Airlines' inaugural flight arrives at Yangon International Airport (YIA) as the 31st international airline flying into YIA on 13 November 2018.

Sichuan Airlines now connects Yangon, the commercial capital city of Myanmar, with Xi'an three times a week utilizing Airbus A320 with the capacity of 163 passengers. The flight tickets for this new route are available with the fare starting from 120 USD (tax excluded) for RGN – XIY (one way) and 170 USD (tax excluded) for a Round Trip via travel agencies in Myanmar or Sichuan Airlines official website: www.sichuanair.com.

With the addition of Sichuan Airlines, 31 international airlines and 29 international destinations are currently operating at YIA. Followed by the Visa on Arrival service for Chinese tourists and Visa Free service for tourists from Japan and South Korea, the growth in the tourist traffic from those countries has been growing. YIA continues its effort in the future expansion of travel routes and to promote tourism to Myanmar inviting more airlines across the globe landing at YIA. We wish Sichuan Airlines all the best.
